

Déclin alarmant du trafic des aéroports européens en 2012

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European airport traffic growth reports alarming decline in 2012

European airport trade body, ACI EUROPE, today released its traffic results for 2012, a year marked by a progressive slowdown in passenger traffic and continued recession for freight traffic. The overall passenger traffic at Europe's airports saw an increase of just +1.8% compared to 2011, with a clear divide between the EU market and other European countries. Passenger traffic at EU airports has been in recession since October and barely grew on yearly basis (+0.2%) while non-EU airports posted a strong performance for the year (+8.8%), led by Turkey, Russia, Georgia, Iceland and Moldova. Freight traffic at European airports for the full year decreased by -2.8% and the overall figure for movements also decreased by -2.1%.
